# Directive (EU) 2019/1151 that amends Directive (EU) 2017/1132

Use of digital tools and processes in company law:

- Online constitution of companies
- Online filing of companies deeds
- Detailed regulation of BRIS Business
   Register Interconnection System

## Online constitution of companies

Member States shall pass a regulation for the constitution of some types of limited liability companies by means of a fully online process.

#### Identification

Art. 13b - Founders have to be identified thourgh digital means compliant with EU Regulation n. 910/2014

### Legality check

Art. 10 - Control by
Tribunal,
administrative body
or notary public.

# Statute: use of templates

Art. 13h - It is only mandatoryfor certain types of companies
